- Gloucester bus station is in walking distance
- The building is accessible, with a wheelchair friendly toilet
- There is a quiet space for anyone feeling overwhelmed

What will we be doing?

Family Days are drop-in sessions, where a parents need to stay

Our youth only days for 10-16 year olds are drop-off sessions, where young people need to remain with us, unless given parental permission to leave.

Below is an outline of what our day will look like:-

11pm -12.30pm – A range of different arts activities (Young people can choose)

We have a free-flow system, where you can rotate around the different activities in the space throughout the day, to allow you to take the time that you need on each arts activity that we provide, to best suit you.

12.30pm - We have lunch around 12.30pm, but you can always tell us if you are hungry before-hand, as we have healthy snacks available

1pm – physical activity – we will take an walk through Eastgate Shopping centre out to the Greyfriars Monastery remains to take rubbings, photos and make drawings to use in the afternoon

1.30pm – 2.45pm – Arts Activities – collage, photography, flag-making etc

2.45pm – 3.00pm – Tidy up and pick-up
